**LEGAL NOTICE OF  
TERMINATION FROM MEDICARE PROGRAM**

Effective on **April 30, 2024**, the Secretary of the Department of Health & Human Services will terminate its Medicare Provider Agreement with Stanislaus Surgical Hospital. A Medicare complaint validation survey conducted on February 5, 2024, found Stanislaus Surgical Hospital was not in compliance with requirements for participation in the Medicare and Medicaid programs as established by the Social Security Act (Section 1861) and its underlying regulations.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has determined that Stanislaus Surgical Hospital was not in compliance with the following nine Medicare Conditions of Participation for Hospital services:

- 42 CFR 482.1 Basis and Scope
- 42 CFR 482.12 Governing Body
- 42 CFR 482.13 Patient Rights
- 42 CFR 482.21 QAPI
- 42 CFR 482.22 Medical Staff
- 42 CFR 482.23 Nursing Services
- 42 CFR 482.25 Pharmaceutical Services
- 42 CFR 482.51 Surgical Services
- 42 CFR 482.52 Anesthesia Services

Medicare and Medicaid programs will not make payments for services furnished to patients who were admitted on or after April 30, 2024. For patients admitted prior to April 30, 2024, payment may be available for up to thirty (30) calendar days after the effective date of termination.

Termination of your participation in the Medicare program will also result in termination of your Medicaid agreement. CMS is forwarding a copy of this letter to the California Medi-Cal Medicaid program. CMS is also sending a copy of this letter to your Medicare Administrative Contractor (MAC), Noridian Healthcare Solutions. Please contact Noridian Healthcare Solutions to arrange for filing a final cost report.
