The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing notice that on January 3, 2024, Henry Mayo Newhall Urgent Care's (23929 McBean PKWY, STE 102, Valencia, CA 91355-4467) CLIA certificate will be limited due to a subsequent occurrence of unsuccessful participation in proficiency testing for the analyte Cell I.D. or WBC Differential.

The facility has been notified that the CLIA certificate was limited on December 19, 2023. When a laboratory's CLIA certificate is limited, it is required to cease all patient iron laboratory testing, including waived and provider-performed microscopy testing regardless of whether or not the laboratory charges for the testing. CMS is committed to patient safety and quality of care.
